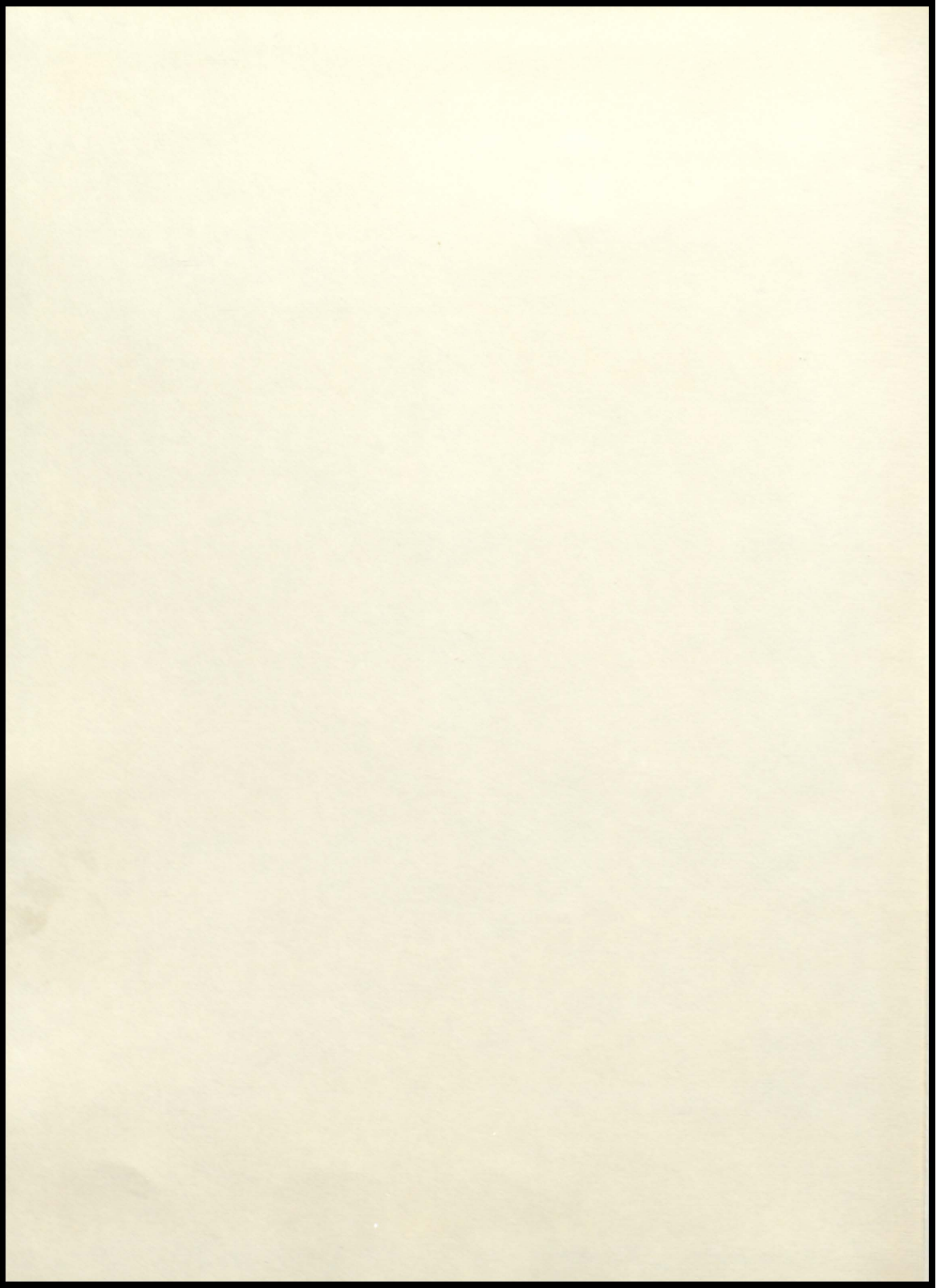

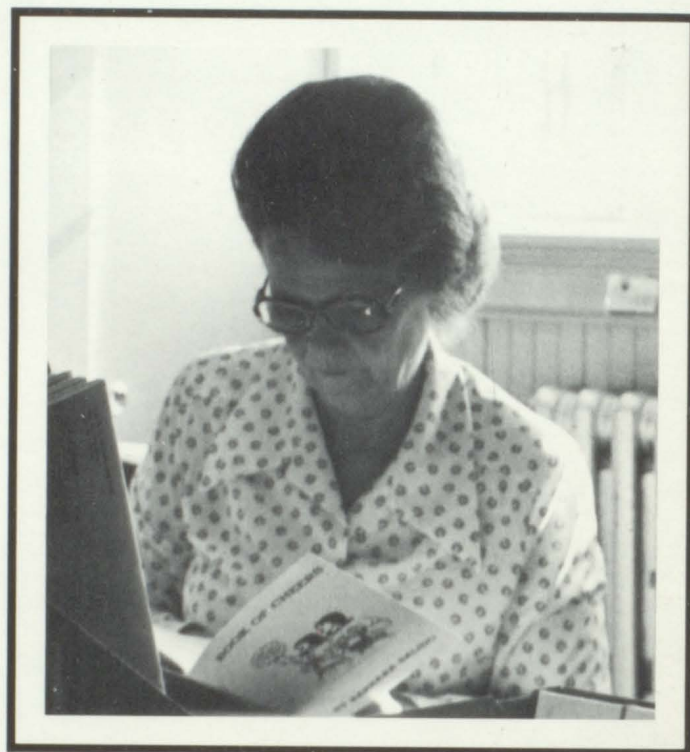


Mr. D. M. Eddleman
